



## WHAT TO EXPECT AT MY DIABETIC EYE SCREENING APPOINTMENT

- 1. Visual acuity test: This test evaluates your visual acuity at different distances by reading letters or symbols on a chart to assess sharpness.
- 2. Dilated eye exam: Eye dilation using Minims Tropicamide (eye drops) allows the screener to examine the back of your eye, including the retina and optic nerve, aiding in the detection of eye conditions like diabetic retinopathy, macular degeneration.
- 3. Retinal photography: Images of your retina may be taken to monitor for any signs of diabetic retinopathy.
- 4. Discussion of results: Your images will be reviewed by our graders, with results expected within 3 weeks. Your General Practitioner will have access to your results and any necessary follow-up care.
